

SYNTONIC OPTOMETRY BASICS - BASIC CURRICULUM - CLASS 101

Syntonic Optometry - Syntonic phototherapy is noninvasive and quick acting.

It works via the application of specific bands of low power light through the eyes. It has been used clinically for over 80 years in the field of optometry with continued success in the treatment of visual and cognitive dysfunction, including strabismus, amblyopia, focusing and convergence problems, learning disorders, and the aftereffects of stress, brain injuries and emotional/mood disorders. Syntonics is based on scientific principles.

Biophotomodulation, the science of light therapy, is one of the fastest growing areas of scientific and clinical research.

Curriculum 101

A two-day basic course, provides participants with in depth knowledge of Syntonic Optometry - Syntonic phototherapy history, theory and handson application of the basic syntonic diagnostic and clinical protocols.

Attendees will learn to look for the source of common visual problems through visual field, pupil and binocular testing unique to syntonics and to apply light to rebalance and remediate the symptoms.

What typical Syntonic Optometry syndromes do we know and what are the basic filter combinations that we use?

How to apply Syntonic Therapy? We will also cover concepts like Nascentization and Syntonic Morphological analyses.
